#### PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

The Parks Foundation is more than the fundraising arm of our Parks Department—as a group, we take great pride in watching our parks grow, improve and be a wonderful asset for our community. I often joke in our Foundation meetings about taking credit for all the things that have been accomplished by the Parks Department and our Foundation during my tenure as President, but the reality is that the best (maybe the only) thing I do is get out of the way of the people doing the work. We are fortunate as a community to have such dedicated leadership, employees, and volunteers to support the many initiatives brought to the table each year.

Here are just a handful of projects that were completed during 2022:

- Major renovation of the wedding walk at Ogden Gardens
- Replacement of the walking bridge and upgraded parking areas at Rogers Lakewood
- Addition of 4 more miles at Creekside Trails
- Creation and installation of Butterfly Meadows Story Walk in partnership with Porter County Public Library System & the opening featuring Kristina Cherep, a local author
- Re-launched Bike Share program, with local sponsors, with 36 bikes and 11 stations
- Increased holiday lighting and installed a new 38-foot Christmas tree with 26,000 lights at Central Park Plaza, thanks to partners
- Improvement of the pickleball courts at Bicentennial and Kirchhoff Parks
- Addition of new piers and kayak launches at Rogers Lakewood Park
- New dugouts at Fairgrounds Park with partners

Creekside and Forest Park Golf Courses continued to flourish, allowing us to invest in cart paths, fencing, parking lots, and exterior and interior clubhouse improvements. Additionally, our City and Parks Department launched the Valpo for All Generations campaign to improve the Valpo Parks system to better serve the citizens of our community. This launch included:

- Formed private/public partnerships of \$1.2 million to build a Skatepark in 2023
- Purchased 248 acres to build Phase 1 of the Valpo Sports & Recreation Campus that will begin construction in 2023 and be completed in the fall of 2024
- Negotiated the acquisition of property and began fundraising for the new Adult Center for Enrichment to be constructed in 2024

All I can say is WOW! The plate is full, and the work continues.

For all the reasons above, I would be remiss if I did not mention that our Parks Department was recognized by the Indiana Parks and Recreation Association as the Outstanding Agency of the Year in 2022! So with that, I will step aside and let the work continue by the outstanding staff, volunteers and members of this Foundation. Thank you again for all your support in making our Parks System what it is today!

#### The Board Gets On Board


2022 brought new strategies for the Parks Foundation. At the 2022 Party in the Park on June 10th, Tim VerSchure announced that the Foundation Board would match the first \$50,000 in donations for the "Get on Board" fundraising campaign for the new Valparaiso Skatepark. The response was enthusiastic and matching donations were raised within 2 months. Additionally, Board members made personal pledges and donations totaling \$189,220 to the Valparaiso for All Generations Campaign. The first phase of the Skatepark is fully funded, but the Parks Department and Foundation are looking for an additional \$350,000 to fund Phase 2 ahead of a Spring 2023 Groundbreaking. #### **Sports Complex Sets Phase 1 Plans**

In October, Valpo Parks hosted an Open House for the new Valpo Sports and Recreation Campus just east of Hwy 49. The new complex will sit on 248 acres stretching from Vale Park Road on the south up to 500 North. Phase 1 of the Complex comes in at \$30 million and will feature 4 multi-sport Astroturf fields for baseball, softball, soccer, and other ball sports, generous parking, pickleball courts, open green space, public restrooms, and an inclusive playground. Astroturf fields have an expected utility of around 20 years and dramatically increase the availability of field use despite weather and foot traffic. Due to the uniform surface, Astroturf also makes the fields inclusive for athletes who use wheelchairs and mobility devices. Future phases will include nature trails, additional fields, and an indoor facility. Donations are welcome as we work toward a Summer 2023 Groundbreaking ahead of a Fall 2024 Opening.
