

Party In The Park







Creekside Trails

More than just golf on the Creekside property

Creekside Trails is home to six miles of multi-use soft surface trails. The Creekside property was purchased by the City of Valparaiso in 1992 from the Johnson family. The property remained unaltered until spring 2019 when a group of community members approached the Parks Department with a vision to bring mountain biking to Valparaiso. In March of 2019, volunteers led by lead trail designer Bob Spaulding, Jr, broke ground and by October of the same year the trail was deemed safe to hike, bike and jog.




ValPAWraiso Dog Park


